- Full abstract in Times New Roman, font size 12
- Abstracts or posters must indicate the subtheme. The subtheme for each abstract must be written below the name(s) of the presenter(s) and be aligned left, bold.

- Deadline for submission of abstracts: 31 August 2024
- Notice of acceptance and registration: 02 September 2024
